# **2026 AGM Speckle Park Junior Show Rules & Regulations**

## **General Rules**

### **Entries**

Exhibitors must submit all entries online no later than June 10, 2026. No late entries will be accepted. The CJSPA will ONLY accept entries submitted with the entry form.

CJSPA will not refund any entry fees. Exhibitors must pay their entry fees prior to the show. All entries or changes must be made in writing before the entry deadline for all classes.

All exhibitors will pay a base exhibitor fee. This exhibitor fee covers the participation of showmanship, fitting, judging, and all satellite classes. Additional fees will be added for animal conformation classes. No additional fee if bringing an animal specifically for showmanship or fitting.

Exhibitors can only have 1 entry per class.

### **Prize Money**

Prize money will be awarded to the top 3 placings in each class (splits not included).

1<sup>st</sup>: \$50    2<sup>nd</sup>: \$30    3<sup>rd</sup>: \$20

## ***Exhibitor Eligibility***

Exhibitors must be 6 as of January 1, 2026. No one who was 22 years or older on January 1, 2026, is eligible to show. If entering in the Satellite portion the exhibitor is not required to attend the show.

CJSPA members and non-members can participate. CJSPA members will have discounted entry fees. Anyone who wishes to receive the discounted fees must be a CJSPA member when submitting entries.

## ***At Show Rules***

### ***Animal Qualifications***

- 1. Commercial Cattle:** Animals with a minimum 12.5% Speckle Park blood qualify as commercial animals. Animals cannot be registered. Cow/calf pair eligibility is based on the cow's bloodlines.
- 2. Purebred Cattle:** Animals must be registered with the CSPA. If the registration process is delayed, proof of submitted registration paperwork will be accepted. Animals are subject to tattoo inspection. Cow/calf pair eligibility is based on the cow's bloodlines.
- 3. Cow/Calf Pairs:** A cow with a natural calf at side is eligible to show in the Cow/Calf Division. Calves can be shown in their own classes apart from their dam.
- 4. Steers:** Steer calves and Fat steers can be commercial or purebred. Steer calves of all percentages will show together and be split into divisions based on age. Fat steers of all percentages will show together and be split into divisions based on weight.

**5. Ownership:** Animals are NOT required to be owned by the exhibitor or the exhibitor's family to participate in confirmation classes. However, if entering a borrowed animal into the PUREBRED section a CSPA lease is required for the duration of the show. Commercial cattle do not require a lease. (email the CSPA office to put a lease in place)

\*\*The term "animal" used throughout these rules refers to bulls, and females alike.\*\*

\*\* It is the exhibitors' responsibility to ensure the exhibitor and their animals qualify for the shows they enter. CJSPA will not give refunds for unqualified exhibitors or animals entered in any show.\*\*

### ***Divisions***

If required, splits of animal classes will be determined after check-in. All classes will line up according to age from youngest to oldest in the show arena, aside from the Fat Steers. The top 2 animals in all female divisions will return for the Champion Commercial or Purebred Female respectively.

### ***Judging, Showmanship, Fitting, Classes***

Judging classes will be split into 4 age divisions: Novice 6-8, Junior 9-12, Intermediate 13-15, Senior 16-21. Judging will be the standard 4-H Canada judging cards.

Showmanship classes will be split into 4 age divisions: Novice 6-8, Junior 9-12, Intermediate 13-15, Senior 16-21. Exhibitors can show any age, breed or sex of animal. The animal being used does not have to be shown in the animal conformation classes. Showmanship will be a dry brush class; no products are permitted.

Fitting classes will be a team format. The teams will be determined by the show board and will all be in one split. Paint products can be used. Clippers and blowers are not permitted to be used in the competition. Any age, breed or sex of animal can be used.

## ***Fitting***

To maintain a high degree of confidence in Speckle Park shows, CJSPA reserves the right to disqualify any animal for unethical fitting, which shall include the following:

- The cutting, tearing or gluing of the hide or underneath the hide or removal of tissue in an attempt to alter the animal's shape.
- The injection of any gas, solid or liquid under the hide to alter the animal's conformation.
- Any attempts to disrupt or change the animal's normal dental development.
- Any products, such as steroids or growth stimulants, administered internally or externally to alter the animal's conformation.
- Any stomach pumping without authorization from a licensed veterinarian.

Colored products (paints, colored foam) are permitted, but should not be used to alter the animals natural color patterns.

## ***Stalling***

Barns will open for move in at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 25, 2026 to accommodate exhibitors arriving early to attend AGM activities.

All animals must be stalled by 8:00am on June 28, 2026. Bedding will be supplied. There will be a water supply. All animals must have a necktie on when indoors. Nurse cows are permitted and there will be holding pens available. All cattle will be released after the awards conclude. Cattle must be off the grounds by 11:59 p.m. June 28, 2026.

Fans and blowers are permitted and power is supplied, optional to bring your own generator.

### ***Attire & Entry Numbers***

Event t-shirts will be supplied and are expected to be worn for the entirety of the event. All exhibitors must clearly display their entry numbers while they are in the marshalling area and in the ring. A show harness with the number on your back is recommended.

### ***Substitute Showmen***

All exhibitors are required to show their own animals. If assistance is needed, the show board will help. In the case of sickness or injury after arrival at the show, exhibitors (who must be present at the show) may select another junior exhibitor to show their animals. The show board must approve substitute showmen before they enter the show ring.

### ***Disposition***

To ensure safety, animals with unruly dispositions will not show. The judge or show board may dismiss exhibitors with unruly animals from the show. They will enforce the rule that after three incidents where the exhibitor loses control of an animal, it will automatically be excused from the ring.

### ***Substitute Animals***

There will be no substitutions for animals allowed.

### ***Agreement of Responsibility and Liability***

Participants must maintain full control, custody, care, and feeding of the animals and personal property that they bring on or about the premises of the show. Participants clearly understand and agree that CJSPA shall not be responsible for any damage, loss, or injury to any person or property that is caused directly or indirectly for any reason at those shows. The exhibitors, owners, their agents, and representatives agree to indemnify CJSPA and CSPA and hold the organizations

harmless for all damages, injuries, losses, expenses, or liabilities they might incur at the show. By entering the show, the participants and their parents or guardians agree to the terms described in this section and agree to comply with all the rules and regulations governing those shows.

## ***Satellite Event Rules***

All classes will be split into 4 age categories: Novice 6-8, Junior 9-12, Intermediate 13-15, Senior 16-21.

### ***Photography***

This contest allows exhibitors to become familiar with the art of photography.

1. **Time:** Competitors must submit their entries electronically by June 15, 2026. All contestants must pre-register by June 10, 2026 using the online entry system. No late entries will be accepted.
2. **Criteria:** Photo submissions must highlight Speckle Park cattle. If there are no speckle park cattle in the photo it will be disqualified. Candid shots, scenic pasture views - any picture featuring a Speckle Park will be accepted.
3. **Exhibitor Rules:**
  - a. ONE ENTRY PER EXHIBITOR
  - b. Photos may be black and white or color. Entries must be submitted as a high-resolution JPEG or PNG file.
  - c. No text is allowed on the photo.
  - d. Camera timer settings may not be used; therefore, the junior submitting the entry may not appear in the photo.
  - e. Photos become the property of CJSPA. By entering, participants agree that CJSPA and CSPA may use the photos in publications and promotions.

**An anonymous selection committee will place the top 3 in every age division. The winners will be announced on June 28, 2026 at awards.**

## **Promotional Poster**

This contest allows exhibitors the ability to design a promotional poster to promote the Speckle Park breed and Speckle Park activities.

1. **Time:** Competitors must submit their entries electronically by June 15, 2026. All contestants must pre-register by June 10, 2026 using the online entry system. No late entries will be accepted.
2. **Topics:**
  - a. Novice & Junior division: Promote Speckle Park Cattle
  - b. Intermediate division: Promote any single Speckle Park animal
  - c. Senior division: Promote any ranch, program, or sale
3. **Exhibitor Rules:**
  - a. Each exhibitor is to design a promotional poster that meets the topic specified for their age division. The poster can be no larger than 8.5 by 11 inches.
  - b. Posters must be submitted as a PDF.
  - c. Novice entries must be handmade and not computer-generated.
  - d. Junior entries may be handmade or computer-generated.
  - e. Intermediate and senior entries must be computer-generated.
  - f. Novice and junior handmade advertisements must be scanned or a picture must be submitted of the original advertisement.
  - g. One entry per contestant.
  - h. Entry must be a NEW poster created specifically for the contest; it cannot have been used in any other manner prior.
  - i. The exhibitor isn't required to own or operate the animal, ranch, program or sale they are promoting. However, they must have permission from the respective party to create a poster on their operation or animal.

**An anonymous selection committee will place the top 3 in every age division. The winners will be announced on June 28, 2026 at awards.**

## **Promotional Video**

This contest allows exhibitors to showcase their talents through videography.

1. **Time:** Competitors must submit their entries electronically by June 15, 2026. All contestants must pre-register by June 10, 2026 using the online entry system. No late entries will be accepted.
2. **Criteria:**
  - a. Exhibitors will submit a 1-2 minute video.
  - b. The topic of the video should be “20 Years of Speckle Park Cattle”
3. **Exhibitor Rules**
  - a. ONE ENTRY PER CONTESTANT
  - b. Entries must be submitted as an mp4 file.
  - c. All videos must be submitted by the original creator of the submission. Entrants must hold all rights to the submission, including copyright. Video must be prepared by the junior member and not professionally created/coordinated in any fashion.
  - d. Videos become the property of CJSPA. By entering, participants agree that CJSPA and CSPA may use the video in publications and promotions.
  - e. Entry must be a NEW video created specifically for the contest; it cannot have been used in any other manner prior.

**An anonymous selection committee will place the top 3 in every age division. The winners will be announced on June 28, 2026 at awards.**
